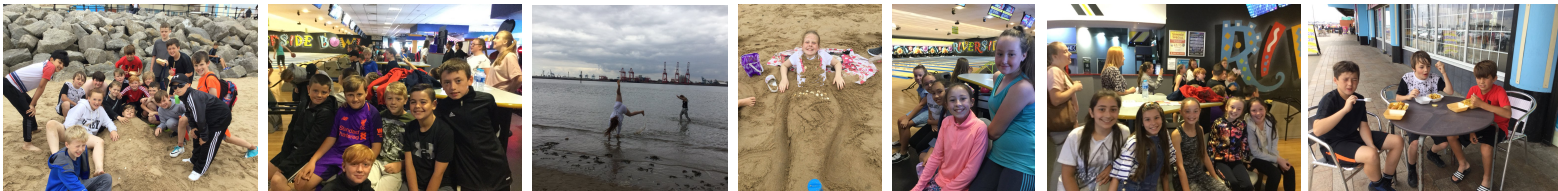
### Year 6 End of Year Prom
