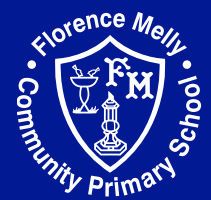

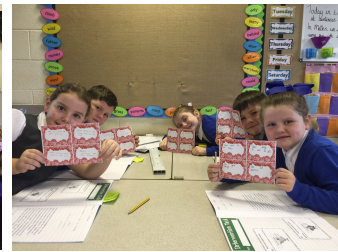

## ANTI-BULLYING WEEK 2018



The theme for Anti-Bullying Week 2018 was to 'choose respect' over bullying and staff have worked hard this week to show our pupils that bullying is a behaviour choice, and that children and young people can set a positive example by opting to respect each other at school, in their homes and communities, and online. The week got off to a great start with a visit from the Power of One show. The show involved actors doing a variety of scenes showing bullies, their targets and bystanders. The children were then invited to discuss what had happened and the best way to deal with each incident. Everyone took an anti-bullying pledge and we were given a huge Bully Prevention Oath for everyone to sign. Classes engaged in the theme during their SMSC lessons by researching, role-playing and designing posters to be put up around school. Some classes also celebrated by wearing odd socks - providing the opportunity for children to express themselves and celebrate their individuality and what makes them all unique! 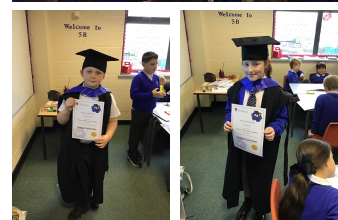


### Attendance Matters at Florence Melly!
