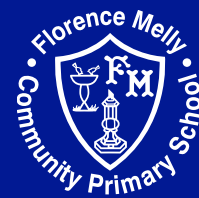

A Visit from a Former Headteacher

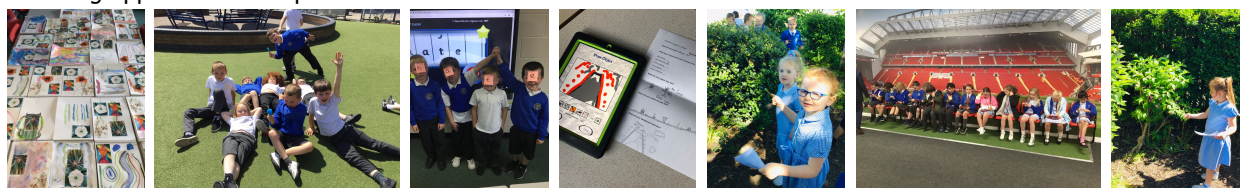
