# DOGS ON THE SCHOOL GROUNDS!

Please be aware, it is part of our parent and carer code of conduct that no dogs or other animals are to be brought on the school premises (except guide dogs). We have noticed in recent months, that more and more dogs have been brought onto the school site during pick up and drop off times. There are multiple reasons why we do not allow dogs or other animals onto the school site, including: children being scared of dogs and animals, potential bites and infections from bites, allergic reactions, including asthmatic symptoms and toxocariasis (an infection spread via dog faeces). We politely ask that no dogs or other animals are brought onto the school grounds at any time and hope that you will support us with this stance. Thank you for your continued support.

Pupils from Year 5 had the opportunity to take part in the unique sport of Bobbleball with the LFC Foundation this week. ### **An Enrichment Trip to Gillmoss Recycling Centre**

On Tuesday some of our Year 5 pupils went to visit the Gillmoss Recycling Centre. They were eager to learn about what happens to our recycling waste once the blue bins have been emptied and the waste is collected. First, the children took part in a fantastic discussion about recycling - why we do it and how can we improve. They also completed some recycling challenges and learnt about what we can and can't recycle. There were so many educational activities to get involved with. After that the children went on a tour of the factory. It was huge! They saw all of the different types of machinery sorting through the different recycling materials. Everybody learnt so much on this enrichment trip.

## **Merseyside Fire and Rescue Workshop**

As part of our partnership with the LFC Foundation, a group of our Year 3 children visited Anfield to take part in a Road Safety workshop being hosted by Merseyside Fire and Rescue Service. The children learnt all about staying safe whilst out and about, dangers they need to look out for and important safety skills. Afterwards, they even had the opportunity to win some prizes and have a few photographs around the ground! It was a fabulous morning!
