Please be aware, it is part of our parent and carer code of conduct that no dogs or other animals are to be brought on the school premises (except guide dogs). We have noticed in recent months, that more and more dogs have been brought onto the school site during pick up and drop off times. There are multiple reasons why we do not allow dogs or other animals onto the school site, including: children being scared of dogs and animals, potential bites and infections from bites, allergic reactions, including asthmatic symptoms and toxocariasis (an infection spread via dog faeces). We politely ask that no dogs or other animals are brought onto the school grounds at any time and hope that you will support us with this stance. Thank you for your continued support.

They also completed some recycling challenges and learnt about what we can and can't recycle. There were so many educational activities to get involved with. After that the children went on a tour of the factory. It was huge! They saw all of the different types of machinery sorting through the different recycling materials. Everybody learnt so much on this enrichment trip.

### Merseyside Fire and Rescue Workshop

As part of our partnership with the LFC Foundation, a group of our Year 3 children visited Anfield to take part in a Road Safety workshop being hosted by Merseyside Fire and Rescue Service. 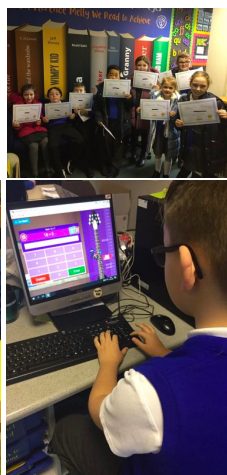
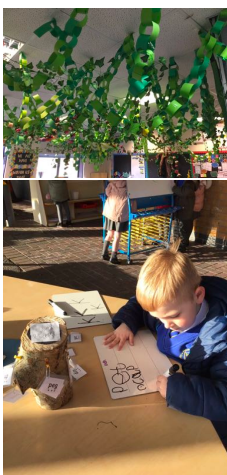

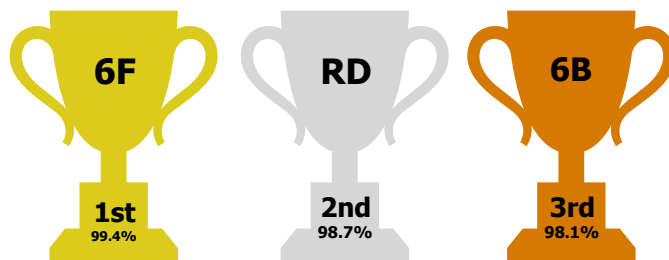
