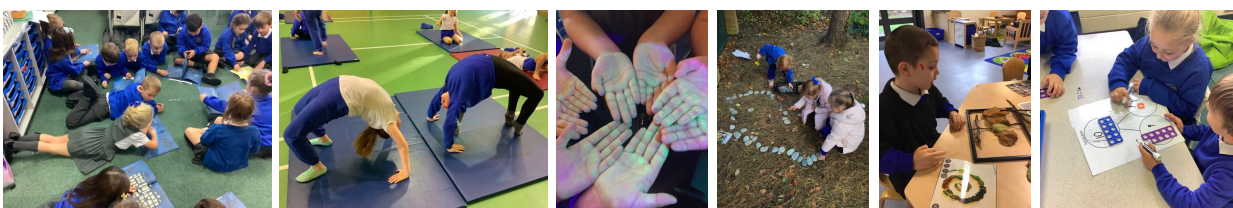


### Anti-Bullying Week 2021!
